


THE RAT

- Rats are very playful animals and love to run, jump and play fight with their family. Rats can even laugh, but humans cannot hear it!




THE OX

- Tigers are nocturnal meaning they are more active at night. They sleep during the day and catch food during the night.




THE RABBIT

- Monkeys yawn to tell other monkeys how they are feeling, usually whether they are angry or happy. Unlike us they do not yawn when they are tired!




THE ROOSTER

- Roosters can remember human faces. So next time you see one make sure you are kind!




THE SHEEP
